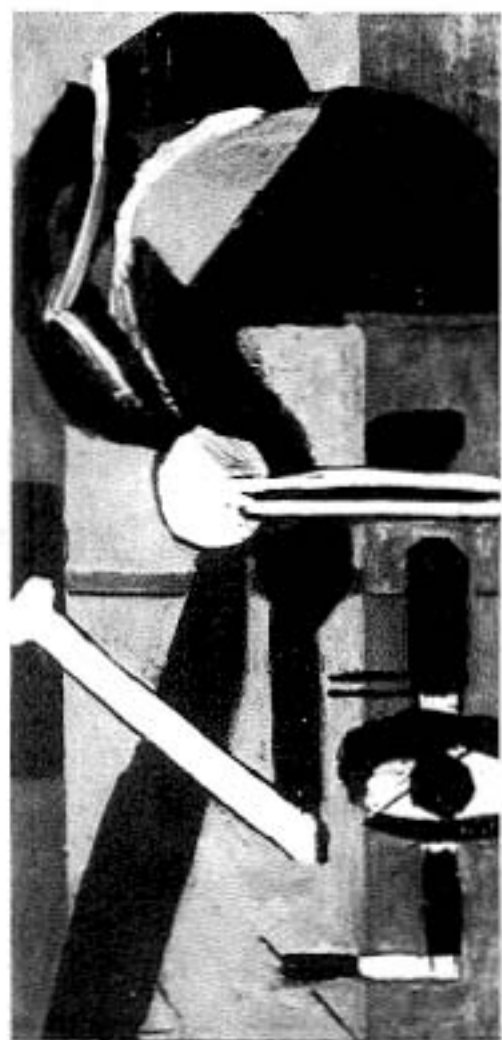
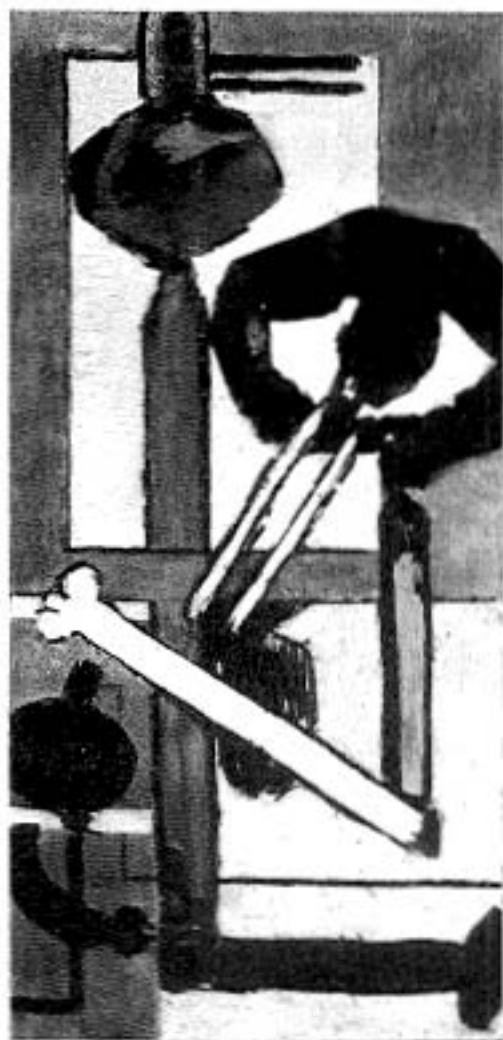

His first exhibition was in the Museum of Modern Art 1952 show, "Sixteen Americans". In 1955, The Curt Valentin Gallery held an exhibition of his paintings and the Museum of Modern Art sent his work on tour through several countries of Europe. In 1961 The Jewish Museum in New York held a retrospective exhibition. Kriesberg is represented in the collections of the Museum of Modern Art, the Whitney Museum, The Chase Manhattan Bank, the Detroit Art Institute, the Baltimore Museum of Art and distinguished private collections.

The present exhibition at the Kumar Gallery includes recent work done in the United States as well as a group of paintings done this autumn in Simla.
